Background History of Myanmar Customs

Myanmar Customs was first established in 1885, while under British occupation. It was known as "Imperial Customs".

British considered Myanmar as one of the India provinces. The India Sea Customs Act entered into force in 1878 and Land Customs Act in 1924.

Background History of Myanmar Customs

Myanmar regained independence on 4th January, 1948. Market-Oriented economic system in 1988-89.

Myanmar Customs Administration reforms its tariff policy and administrative procedures. Myanmar Customs adopted the Harmonized System and amended in 1992, .

It has also applied most of the basic principles of Revised Kyoto Convention for simplification and harmonization of customs procedures to enhance trade efficiency.





Implementation for e-Customs

- ✓ Myanmar Customs is implementing a new generation of Customs computer automation system known as “e-Customs”. e-Customs utilizes Internet services, and is consistent with the standards and guidelines expressed in the Revised Kyoto Convention (RKC) and ASEAN The Strategic Plan of Customs Development (SPCD)
- ✓ Myanmar Customs Department ICT Section was established since 21st May 2008.
- ✓ E-Customs Single Window Working Group was established since 1st November 2007.
- ✓ Myanmar Customs official website hosted in October 2011.
