Purpose of SADKN

- South Asia: one of the most disaster prone regions in the world- range of hazards, highly populous, shared natural resource base, shared hazards and risks;
- A strong need for sharing information, issues common to many countries in the region to inform more efficient DRR planning, decision making and implementation
- SDMC as the focal organization for DRR in the SAARC took the lead in partnership with the UNISDR, to invest on developing the SADKN portal- hardware and software

Management

Two main aspects:

- Management of information coordination
- Management of the Portal

Issues of demand and supply

Challenges

Demand

- Current demands by the member countries and SDMC
- Making the demand dynamic and responsive to effective DRR in the region
- Making the demand responsive to new developments,

Supply

- Make the information available in ways to meet the changing needs and demands of governments and other stakeholders
- Dynamic and innovative ways of making information available
- Value addition- from the other portals/sources of information available

Challenges

- Establishing and maintaining a well knit system between the 8 member countries and the SDMC for:
 - Coordination of generation of information
 - Uploading information/authentication
 - Use and application of information by the members of the national networks

Way forward

Ownership and appreciation of the system as valuable source by the member states, by SAARC

- Internalise SADKN as the main source of information
- Ensure practical usefulness
- Value addition for the SAARC region

Way forward

Regular updating:

- Information,
- knowledge upgrading of the country Focal Points
 - Design: user friendly, innovative dynamic, continuous dialogue, responsive to changes
- Turn into a dynamic platform for forum and dialogue

Way forward


Multiple objectives and uses:

- Platform for dialogue : between countries, stakeholders, priority themes
- Awareness building, enhancing knowledge of professionals, scientific community and the general public
- Sharing good practice
- Connect to the regional and global sources, processes, resources

Towards a post-2015 DRR Framework

- Requested by the UN General Assembly (GA) Resolution A/RES/66/199
- UNISDR is facilitating a multistakeholder consultation process
- Consultation process engages a full range of actors from Member States to civil society, events include regional platforms, the Global Platform, national and local events, and targeted events of DRR stakeholders, partners and networks.
- Builds on the Hyogo Framework for Action 2005-2015 (HFA) - *Building the Resilience of Nations and Communities to Disasters*.
- Expected to be adopted by the World Conference for Disaster Risk Reduction and endorsed by the GA in 2015.
