

- (b) Framework Agreement for Cooperation for Development, Dhaka, August 2011.
  - Holistic approach: Cooperation across sectors preferred to single issues for paired exchange.
  - Security & border: Demarcation of border in the spirit of Agreement of 1974; separatists, insurgents, etc. not to operate from each other's territory; return of criminals & convicts subject to conditions
  - Trade: Acceptance of quality certificate of BSTI; removal of PTB & NTB; reduction of negative list; trade facilitation measures; border haat.
  - Investment: Cross-border investment to be promoted more investment in Bangladesh expected.

01/08/2013

- Water: Progressive agreement on shared or common rivers, augmentation as stipulated in GWST 1996.
- Transit / transshipment: Agreement preexisted for a long time; trans-shipment as part of transit; chicken neck as crippling colonial legacy.
- Education, science, & culture: Celebration of Tagore's 150th Birth Anniversary as symbol & reinforcement of common cultural / literary heritage; 300 additional scholarship for academics & government officials; collaboration in scientific / technical research.

01/08/2013

- Beyond India: Cooperation with Bhutan & Nepal, particularly in water & hydro-power generation and distribution.
- Flexible modalities & Instruments: Other countries may be admitted to the Framework Agreement by amendment or may join particular projects by specific contract.
- Termination: Termination on notice by aggrieved party and if the committee constituted by the parties fail to resolve the issue within six
