

CAREER PATTERNS OF WOMEN IN LOGISTICS






CURRENT POSITION





The female logistics executives are well educated, with as many achieving graduate degrees as undergraduate degrees.


More than one quarter of respondents have degrees in logistics or SCM at the undergraduate or graduate levels.




WHAT IS LIKED LEAST ABOUT BEING A LOGISTICS PROFESSIONAL



WHAT IS LIKED BEST ABOUT BEING A LOGISTICS PROFESSIONA






I AM GENERALLY SATISFIED WITH MY CURRENT POSITION



THE OPPORTUNITIES FOR BUILDING A SOUND PROFESSIONAL CAREER IN LOGISTICS ARE BETTER TODAY THAN EVER BEFORE





FIFTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE RESPONDENTS (55%) FELT IT WAS SOMEWHAT DIFFICULT OR VERY DIFFICULT TO BALANCE A CAREER AND FAMILY. THIS IS THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGE IN SEVERAL YEARS. IN 2005, 53% CONSIDERED IT DIFFICULT OR VERY DIFFICULT TO BALANCE WORK AND FAMILY.
