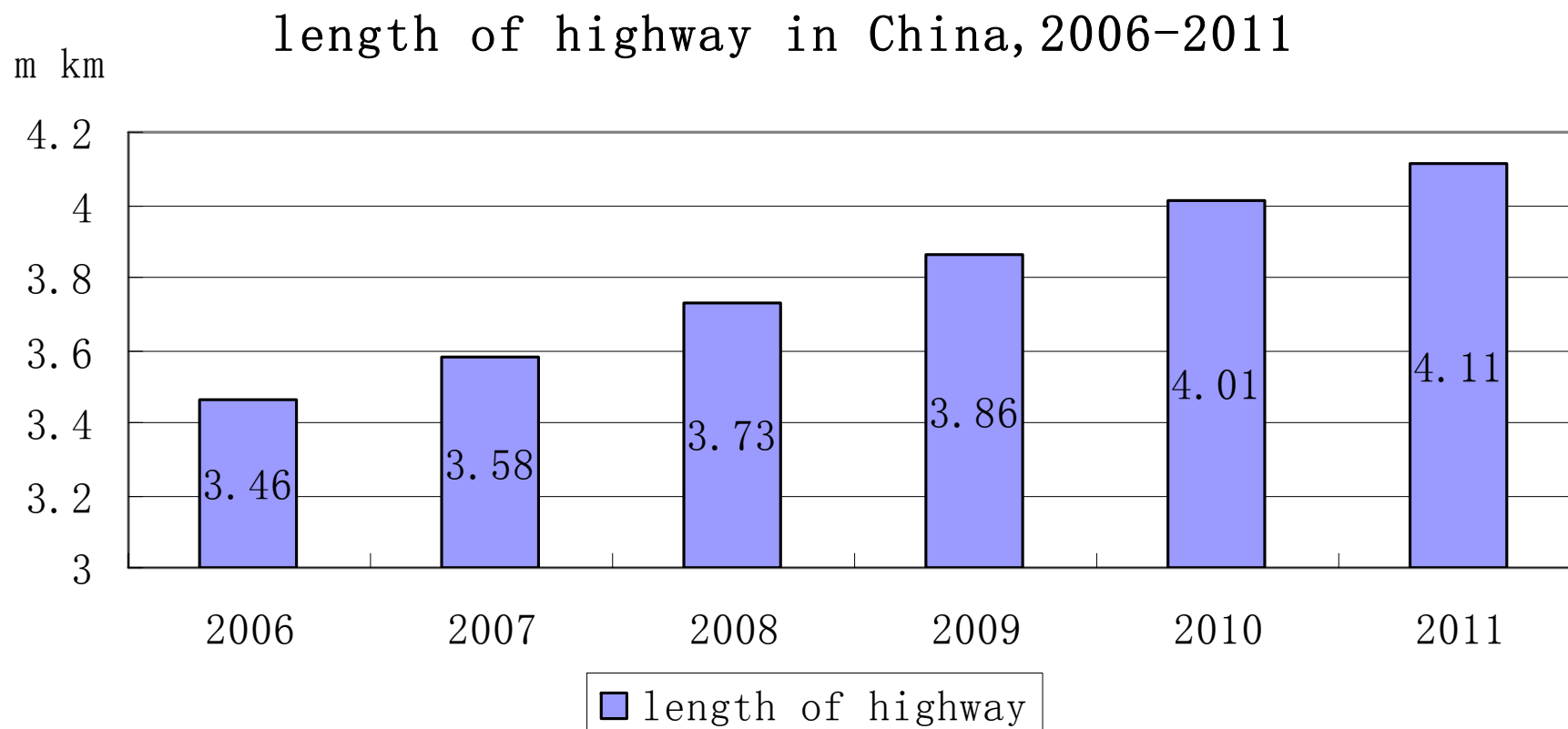

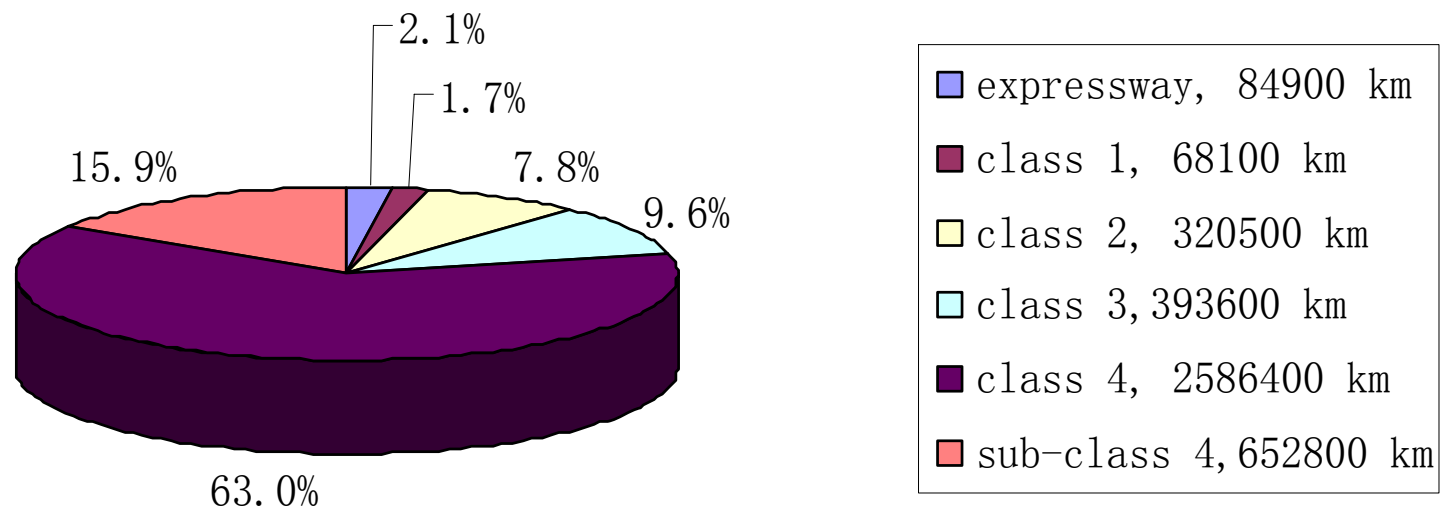

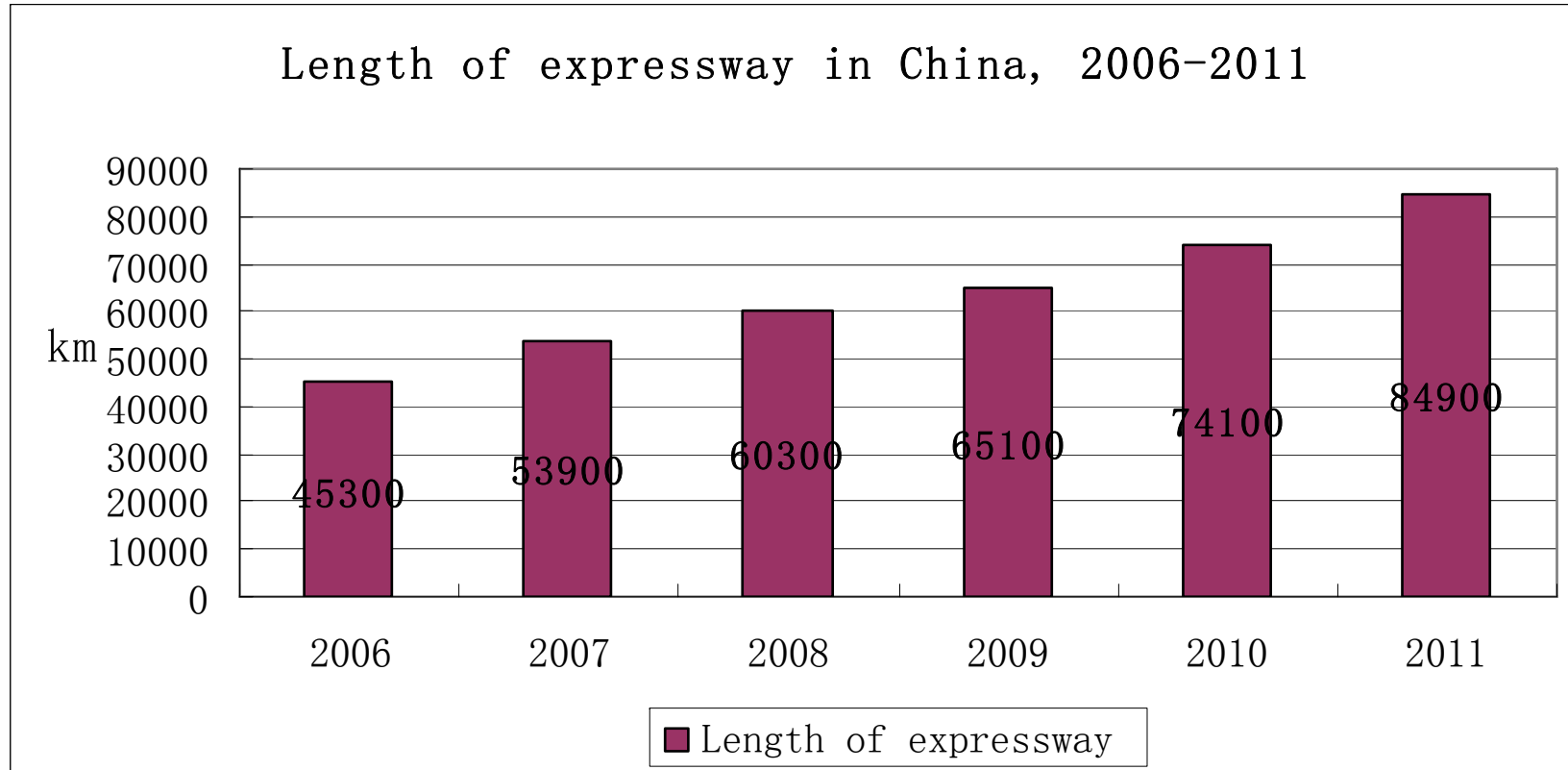
The quality of Road Improved

Highway breakdown by China's classification standards, 2011



As of the end of 2011, the 4.1 million km highways, including 474,000 km – or about 11.5% -- of expressway and classes 1 and 2

Expressway Network Expanding



The Length of expressway increased from 45300 km in 2006 to 84900 in 2011, ranking second in the world; and approximately 64000 km are classified as China's National Expressway

Goods Transported of Road

Road transport delivered around 28.1 billion metric tons of cargo in 2011, shouldering the majority share, 76.3%, of the total freight transport (road, rail, inland water)

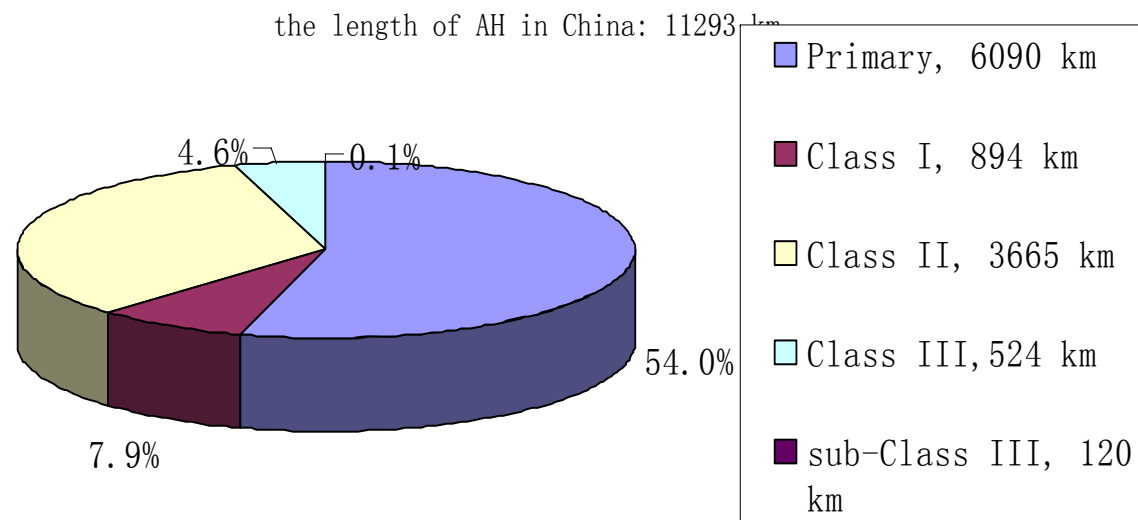
