




# Highway Infrastructure Status of China Overview of the Asian Highway Network (AH) within China Progress on Cross-boarder Road Transport Facilitation

#### **Highway Network Status**




#### The quality of Road Improved

Highway breakdown by China's classification standards, 2011



As of the end of 2011, the 4.1 million km highways, including 474000 km – or about 11.5% -- of expressway and classes 1 and 2

#### **Expressway Network Expanding**



The Length of expressway increased from 45300 km in 2006 to 84900 in 2011, ranking second in the world; and approximately 64000 km are classified as China's National Expressway

### **Goods Transported of Road**

Road transport delivered around 28.1 billion metric tons of cargo in 2011, shouldering the majority share, 76.3%, of the total freight transport (road, rail, inland water)
