- Deploying convergence communication and future network testbed
 - Promotion through sharing research results based on collaborative relationship among academia, industries and government
 - Provides Future internet research environments (DCN,OF)
- Up to 60Gbps Backbone Capacity & 1/10Gbps User Connections
- 60-Gigabit Member institutes (mainly for research & development)

APII/TEIN4

- (APII) Asia Pacific Information Infrastructure (KR-JP)
 - 10Gbps between KR and JP (Advanced Applications and Collaborative Networks)
 - KOREN/APII/JGN-X participate in APII Testbed project related APEC-TEL
- (TEIN4) Trans Eurasia Information Network (KR-Asia-EU)
 - 2.5G between KR-HK, and HK-SG, now under preparation for upgrade
 - Advanced Applications and Collaborative Networks within Asia and EU countries


Global Connectivity

- New initiatives endorsed by ASEM3 meeting (Oct. 2000, Seoul)
- Contribute to enhancing exchanges and cooperation between Asia and Europe through increased and more effective information flows;
- Enhance and diversify research exchanges and cooperation
- Expand and diversify speedier and more powerful telecommunication connections between Asia and Europe

Evolution of TEIN

2000 TEIN Initiative endorsed @ASEM3 (Seoul)

2001 TEIN KR-FR launched (2Mbps)

TEIN quoted as "the basis of a strong partnership

b/w Asia & Europe" @ASEM4 (Copenhagen)

Mar, 2006 TEIN3 Outline Proposal – extended to South Asia partners (EU funding 12M Euro)

Sep, 2006 TEIN2 Launch Event @ ASEM6 Summit

Dec, 2009 ASEM/TEIN3 Workshop - TEIN*CC proposal

2003 TEIN KR-FR upgraded to 45M

Jan, 2004 TEIN2 announced by EU, funding 10M Euro for ASEM-Asia(SEA) partners

Dec, 2004 TEIN1(KR-FR) upgraded to 155M

Oct, 2010 TEIN4 and TEIN*CC endorsed @ ASEM8 Summit (Brussels)


Aug, 2011 TEIN*CC establish in Seoul, KOREA
