# Sustainable Energy for All

- The UN SG Ban Ki Moon is leading a new global initiative: Sustainable Energy for All
- By 2030, the three-fold aim of this initiative is to:
  - Ensure universal access to modern energy services
  - Double the rate of improvement in energy efficiency
  - Double the share of renewable energy in the global energy mix
- In recognition of the importance of energy for sustainable economic development, the UN General Assembly has designated 2012 as the International Year of Sustainable Energy for All

# Rio+20 Outcomes and Implications for Energy sector

- The Conference focused on two themes:
  - Green economy in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication
  - The institutional framework for sustainable development
- Renewed political commitment for sustainable development including commitment to act:
  - to make sustainable energy for all a reality and through this, help eradicate poverty and lead to sustainable development and global prosperity
  - to promote sustainable modern energy services for all through national and sub-national efforts
  - to improve energy efficiency, increase the share of renewable energy, cleaner and energy-efficient technologies

## ESCAP Commission Resolution 67/2

- Promoting regional cooperation for enhanced energy security and the sustainable use of energy in Asia and the Pacific
- Requests the Executive Secretary to convene the APEF 2013
- To discuss the progress achieved in the Asia-Pacific region in addressing the energy security challenges, and to facilitate continuous dialogue among member States with a view to enhancing energy security
