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

## Key challenges for further enhancing training in member countries (1)

- ☑Some countries do not have regular and long-term training programme and the training activities are largely *ad-hoc*
- ☑The training certificates have not been well recognized by industry or government.
- ☑Many countries do not have a pathway in developing training from basic to advanced level.
