Key Outcomes

- ➤ Ministers reaffirmed their vision of an international, integrated, intermodal transport and logistics system
- Ministers adopted Ministerial Declaration on Transport Development in Asia and the Pacific, including two annexes:
 - → Regional Action Programme for Transport Development, phase II (2012-2016)
 - → Regional Strategic Framework for the Facilitation of International Road Transport (RSF)

10 Thematic Areas of Regional Action Programme

- Policy guidance at the ministerial level
- Transport infrastructure development
- Transport facilitation
- Transport logistics
- Finance and private sector participation
- Sustainable transport development
- Road safety
- Transport and the Millennium Development Goals
- Inter-island shipping
- Connecting subregional transport networks

Elements of Example Thematic Areas

O Transport infrastructure development

Objective:

 To promote regional and interregional connectivity and cooperation through the further development and upgrading of the Asian Highway (AH) and Trans-Asian Railway (TAR) networks as well as Euro-Asian transport linkages and dry ports

Activities:

- Meetings of working groups on AH and TAR
- Intergovernmental agreement on dry ports
- Studies, meetings and capacity-building on integrated transport development, upgrading and maintenance of AH, TAR, dry ports and seaports
- Studies on international intermodal transport corridors serving inter- and intraregional trade
- Updated information and data measuring progress in the development of regionally important transport infrastructure and operations
- Activities within the joint UNESCAP-UNECE project on the development of Euro-Asian transport links

Elements of Example Thematic Areas

Transport facilitation

Objective:

 To promote efficient and smooth movement of goods, passengers and vehicles by road and rail across the region, including at border crossings

O Activities:

- Establishment of regional network of legal & technical experts on transport facilitation and development of action plan for implementation of RSF
- Workshops/studies on regional and subregional cooperation
- Study to identify issues surrounding regional cooperation for facilitation of international railway transport
- Assistance in acceding to and implementing international transport facilitation conventions and in formulating & implementing subregional agreements related to facilitation of international transport by road/rail
- Advisory services/workshops on establishment or strengthening of national facilitation coordination mechanisms and on joint controls at borders to facilitate international road/rail transport
- Studies/workshops on application of ICT and other new technologies as well as time/cost distance toolkit to facilitate international road/rail transport

Elements of Example Thematic Areas

Transport logistics

Objective:

 To assist countries in developing transport logistics policies and in enhancing the professionalism and competence of logistics service providers

O Activities:

- Guidelines for development of transport logistics policies
- Guidelines for establishment of minimum standards and codes of conduct for logistics service providers
- Regional meetings of freight forwarders, multimodal transport operators and logistics service providers and their national associations
- Technical assistance and support to the industry and to governments for a sustainable training programme
