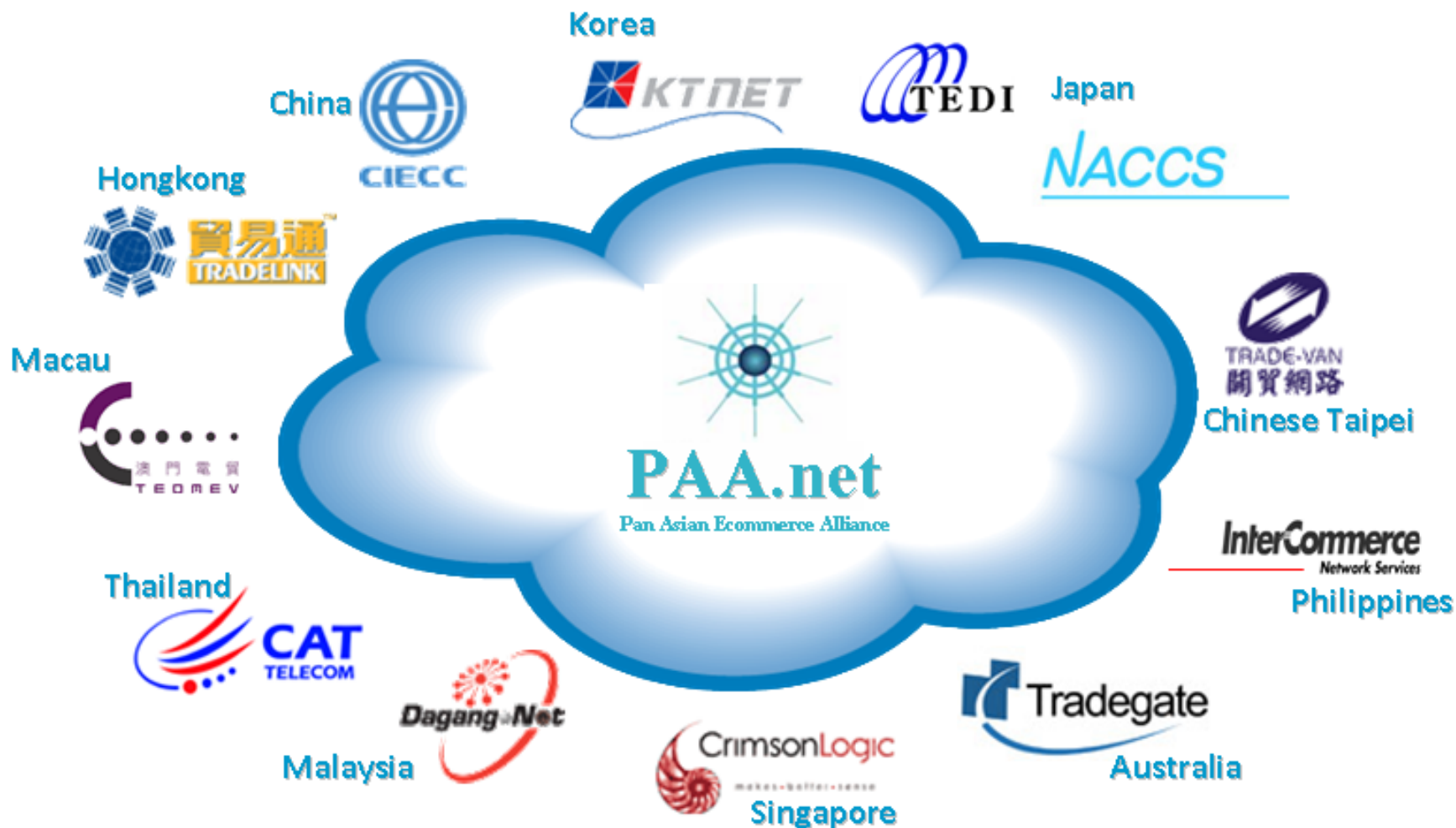
PAA Mission

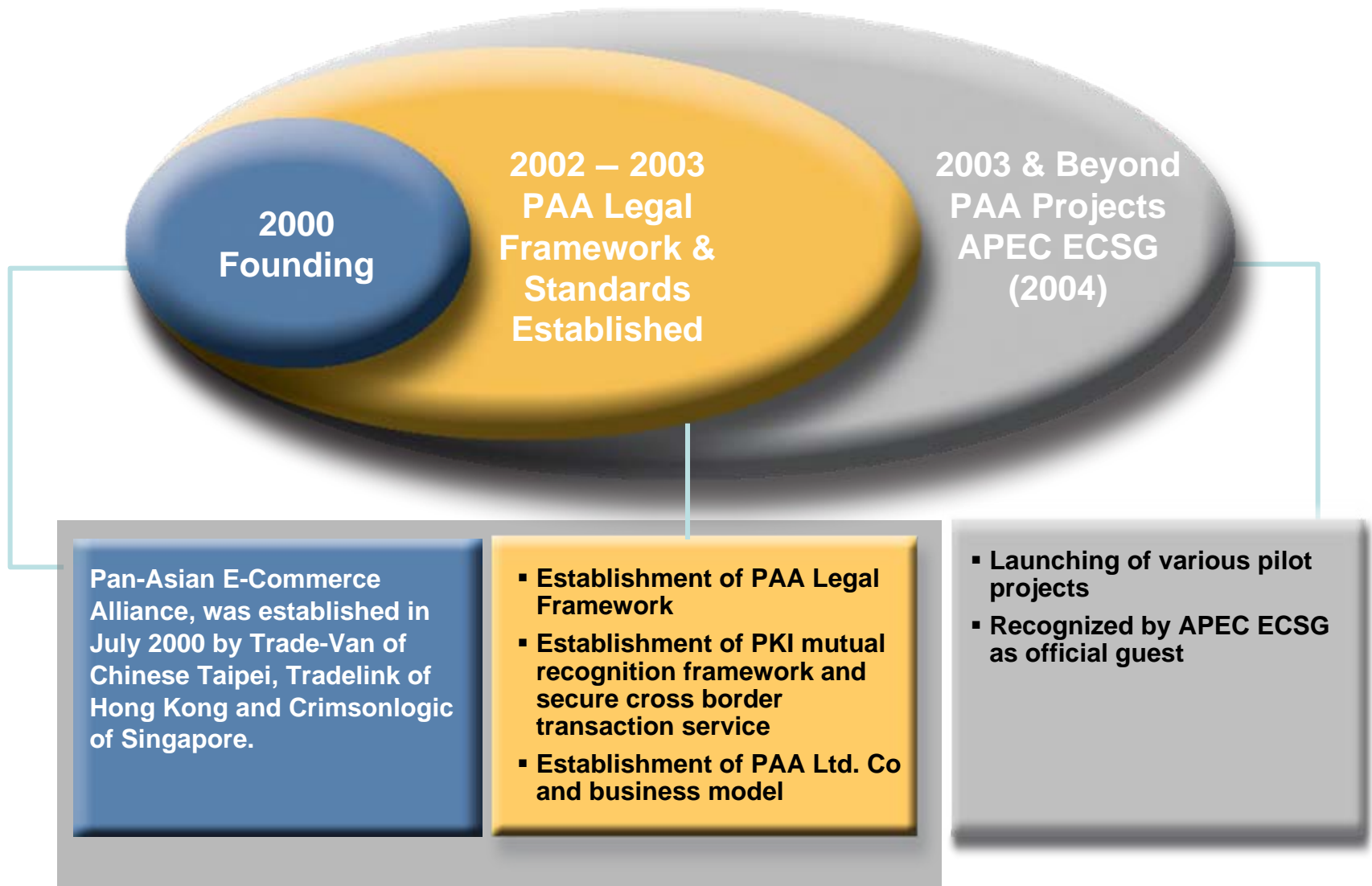
- To enable secure and reliable transmission of trade and logistics documents.
