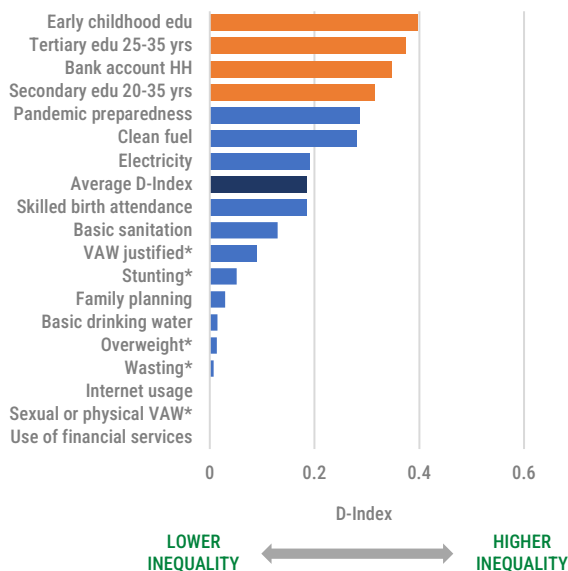

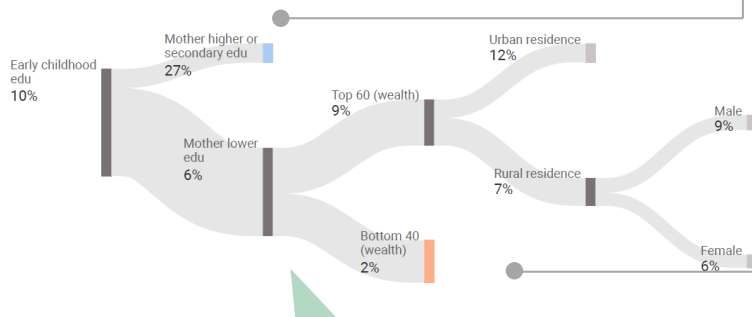


EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION
