No. 4843. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT
OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK REPUBLIC AND THE GOV-
ERNMENT OF THE ROMANIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC
CONCERNING CULTURAL CO-OPERATION. SIGNED
AT PRAGUE, ON 25 OCTOBER 1958

The Government of the Czechoslovak Republic and the Government of the Romanian People's Republic,

Desiring to strengthen and develop further the friendly relations between the Czechoslovak and Romanian peoples and to intensify and widen cultural and scientific contacts in all spheres between the two countries,

Have decided to conclude this Agreement and have for this purpose appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Czechoslovak Republic :

Dr. František Kahuda, Minister of Education and Culture,

The Government of the Romanian People's Republic :

Vasile Dumitrescu, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs,

who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The Contracting Parties shall strengthen and develop co-operation between the two countries in science, education, culture and sport, and each shall acquaint its people with the cultural wealth of the other country and with its achievements in the aforementioned fields.

Article 2

In the field of science the Contracting Parties shall foster and encourage co-operation between academies of science, higher educational institutions and other scientific institutions through :

- (a) The continuous exchange of experience;
- (b) The interchange of scientific workers for study visits, lectures and participation in scientific meetings;
- (c) The exchange of scientific works, publications and study materials.
