No. 5642. AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING CULTURAL,
SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST
REPUBLICS AND THE REPUBLIC OF INDIA. SIGNED
AT NEW DELHI, ON 12 FEBRUARY 1960

The Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Government of the Republic of India,

Desirous of further developing and strengthening their existing friendly relations in every possible way, and to promote further understanding and closer co-operation in the fields of culture, education, science and technology between the two countries,

Have decided to conclude an Agreement and have appointed for this purpose as their respective plenipotentiaries,

For the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics :

Mr. G. A. Zhukov, Chairman of the Committee of the Council of Ministers of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics for Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries;

For the Government of the Republic of India :

Shri Humayun Kabir, Minister of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs of the Government of the Republic of India,

who, having communicated to each other their full powers, found to be in good and due form, have agreed upon the following provisions :

Article 1

The High Contracting Parties declare their desire to maintain and strengthen co-operation in the fields of education, arts, science and technology.

Article 2

The High Contracting Parties express their desire to promote mutual cultural exchange, to stimulate co-operation and support the development of relations between the educational, scientific, technological, cultural, sporting,
