Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to the request by your Government dated May 17, 1960,² for a grant by the Government of the United States to assist the Government of the Republic of Korea in the acquisition of certain nuclear and research training equipment and materials, and to inform Your Excellency's Government that approval of this grant has now been given.

I further have the honor to propose the following understandings on the basis of which funds are to be furnished :

1. Funds granted by the Government of the United States in accordance with this note shall be available only to purchase such equipment and materials, or their equivalents, in such amounts, and not in excess of such prices as may be established by the United States Atomic Energy Commission. Any difference between the amounts and prices established by the United States Atomic Energy Commission and the actual amounts and costs may not be applied by the Government of the Republic of Korea toward purchase of other items or for any other purpose.
