Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to recent conversations between representatives of our two Governments concerning a grant to the Government of Israel by the Government of the United States to assist in the acquisition of certain nuclear research and training equipment and materials, and to inform Your Excellency's Government that approval of this grant has now been given.

I further have the honor to propose the following understandings on the basis of which funds are to be furnished :

1. Funds granted by the Government of the United States in accordance with this note shall be available only to purchase such equipment and materials, or their equivalents, in such amounts, and not in excess of such prices as may be established by the United States Atomic Energy Commission. Any difference between the amounts and prices established by the United States Atomic Energy Commission and the actual amounts and costs may not be applied by the Government of Israel toward purchase of other items or for any other purpose.

2. The Government of Israel, or its designated agent, shall procure, or arrange for procurement of, all equipment and materials to be financed by the grant referred to above and shall meet, from resources other than the granted funds, the costs of transporting, insuring while in transit, installing, and operating the equipment and materials.
