Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to conversations which have recently taken place between representatives of our two Governments relating to the request by the Government of Colombia for economic assistance from the Government of the United States of America.

The Government of the United States of America agrees to provide economic assistance to the Government of Colombia in accordance with written arrangements to be entered into by appropriate agencies of the two Governments. Articles II, III, and IV of the General Agreement for Technical Cooperation between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Colombia, which entered into force on March 9, 1951, as amended,² shall apply to all such assistance and arrangements and shall be deemed to refer equally to assistance furnished hereunder. The above-mentioned arrangements shall include, as appropriate, the standard provisions contained in project agreements entered into pursuant to said Agreement.

The Government of Colombia will consider any mission and its personnel in Colombia to discharge the responsibilities of the Government of the United States of America hereunder as part of the diplomatic mission of the United States of America in Colombia for the purpose of enjoying the privileges and immunities accorded to that diplomatic mission and its personnel.
