No. 6195. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF SWEDEN ON A HUMAN RIGHTS SEMINAR IN STOCKHOLM. SIGNED AT NEW YORK ON 1 JUNE 1962

The United Nations and the Government of Sweden (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON JUDICIAL AND OTHER REMEDIES AGAINST THE ABUSE OF ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY, WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON THE ROLE OF PARLIAMENTARY INSTITUTIONS

1. A United Nations human rights seminar on this topic will be held in Stockholm, Sweden.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 12 to 25 June 1962, inclusive.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to provide an opportunity for exchange of experience and information in the field of the seminar topic.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

Participation in the seminar shall be open to :

a) National participants and alternates nominated by the governments of states in Europe which are Members of the United Nations or of a specialized agency, and confirmed by the Secretary-General. A chairman shall be elected by the national participants from among themselves to preside at the seminar. Vice-chairmen and rapporteurs shall also be elected as appropriate in the same manner.

b) Observers from other States Members of the United Nations.
