Dear Mr. Acting Director General :

I have the honor to inform you that the Government of the United States is prepared to grant to the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), the equivalent of two million dollars in Egyptian currency, and the equivalent of five hundred thousand dollars in either Egyptian or Sudanese currency, or both, as shall be determined by the Government of the United States, to be used by UNESCO to help pay for the direct costs of removing some or all of the temples and monuments at Kertassi, Gerf Hussein, Beit el Wali, Dakka, Maharraka, Dendur, Wadi es Sebu, Amada, Derr, Elleysa, Kasr Ibrim, Aniba, Abu-Oda and Jebel Shams, located in the United Arab Republic, and at Aksha, Debeira, Buhen, Abd el Kadir, Semna and Kumma, located in the Republic of Sudan. The funds are made available for the purpose of protecting the temples and monuments listed above from inundation as a result of the construction of the Aswan High Dam.

The Government of the United States desires that the grant be upon the following conditions :

1. The funds shall not be used—
 - a. To remove or preserve any temple or monument not listed above.
