No. 6426. AGREEMENT¹ ON CULTURAL AND SCIENTIFIC
CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE REVOLUTIONARY
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CUBA AND THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC RE-
PUBLIC. SIGNED AT BERLIN, ON 29 MARCH 1961

The Revolutionary Government of the Republic of Cuba and the Government of the German Democratic Republic, desiring to strengthen and further develop the friendly relations between the Republic of Cuba and the German Democratic Republic, to encourage understanding between the two peoples through instruction in each other's progressive traditions and achievements in the fields of culture, education and science and to contribute to the consolidation of world peace by co-operation between the two peoples, guided by the principles of respect for national independence and sovereignty, have resolved to conclude the following Agreement.

For this purpose they have appointed as their Plenipotentiaries :

The Revolutionary Government of the Republic of Cuba :

Dr. Armando Hart Dávalos, Minister of Education,

The Government of the German Democratic Republic :

Dr. Alfred Lemmnitz, Minister of Education,

who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The Contracting Parties shall endeavour to bring their peoples closer together and to promote relations between them in the fields of science and culture. They further undertake to spread, through their universities and other institutions, knowledge of the political, economic and cultural development of the other country.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties shall support the establishment of cultural centres in each other's countries. The details shall be settled by a special agreement.
