Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the exchange of views between us regarding visas for holders of diplomatic and service passports, and to suggest that an agreement in the following terms be concluded :

(A) 1. The Government of Israel shall exempt holders of valid Sierra Leone diplomatic passports from the obligation to obtain a visa for the purpose of entering or leaving Israel.

2. The Government of Sierra Leone shall exempt holders of valid Israel diplomatic passports from the obligation to obtain a visa for the purpose of entering or leaving Sierra Leone.

3. Holders of Israel diplomatic passports exercising official functions in Sierra Leone or whose stay there exceeds the period of three months, shall apply in Sierra Leone for the usual permits of residence.

4. Holders of Sierra Leone diplomatic passports exercising official functions in Israel, or whose stay there exceeds the period of three months, shall apply in Israel for the usual permits of residence.

(B) 1. The Government of Sierra Leone shall exempt holders of valid Israel service passports from the obligation to obtain a visa for the purpose of entering or leaving Sierra Leone.

A service passport is issued in Israel to Government officials and emissaries not members of the Civil Service who are proceeding abroad on a Government mission.
