No. 6513. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OF AUSTRIA REGARDING THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE VIENNA CONFERENCE ON CONSULAR RELATIONS. SIGNED AT VIENNA, ON 29 JANUARY 1963

Whereas, upon the invitation of the Federal Government of Austria (hereinafter referred to as the Government), the United Nations Conference on Consular Relations (hereinafter referred to as the Conference) shall be held in Vienna from 4 March to 20 April 1963 (if necessary, to be prolonged for one week, to 27 April 1963), therefore the Government and the United Nations hereby agree as follows :

I. PREMISES, EQUIPMENT, UTILITIES AND STATIONERY SUPPLIES

(1) The Government shall make available at its expense such conference rooms and offices in the Neue Hofburg as will be necessary for the Conference. These facilities shall include two large conference rooms for plenary meetings and meetings of the two Committees of the Conference, two smaller conference rooms for meetings of the General Committee, the Credentials Committee and the Drafting Committee(s), three small committee rooms for private meetings of delegations, a delegates' lounge, suitable working areas and all necessary equipment for documents reproduction and documents distribution, a room for a library and reference centre and suitable office accommodation (a minimum of 65 offices) for the staff of the Conference.

(2) The Government shall at its expense furnish, equip and maintain in good repair all the aforementioned rooms and offices in a manner adequate to the effective conduct of the Conference. The large conference rooms and the smaller conference rooms shall be equipped for simultaneous interpretation in four languages and also have facilities for sound recording. The Government shall also provide suitable facilities for the press, radio, and film operations.

(3) The Government shall provide if possible within the Conference area bank, post office, telephone and cable facilities.

(4) The Government shall pay for all necessary utility services including telephone communications of the Secretariat of the Conference within Vienna and communications by Telex between the Secretariat of the Conference and the European Office of the United Nations in Geneva.
