No. 6567. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN FINLAND, DENMARK,
NORWAY AND SWEDEN ON NORDIC-TANGANYIKAN
TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION. SIGNED AT HELSINKI,
ON 15 JANUARY 1963

Whereas, on 15 December 1962, the Governments of Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden concluded an agreement (hereinafter referred to as "the main agreement") with the Government of Tanganyika concerning the establishment and operation of a technical assistance project (hereinafter referred to as "the project") in Tanganyika, the aforementioned Nordic Governments, desiring in the spirit of the Nordic Co-operation Agreement to conclude an agreement on co-operation in the development and execution of the project, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

All costs incurred by the Nordic States in connexion with the project shall be apportioned among them on a scale corresponding roughly to the scale of assessments on which their contributions to the United Nations are based, namely, Denmark four-twentieths, Finland three-twentieths, Norway three-twentieths and Sweden ten-twentieths.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties shall establish a committee, which, save as otherwise provided in this Agreement, may take decisions concerning the execution of the project in accordance with the main agreement and within the limits of such sums as the Contracting Parties have allocated or are to allocate to the committee for purposes of the project.

Article 3

The Contracting Parties shall each appoint two representatives and one alternate representative to the committee. The committee shall elect its own chairman and one or more vice-chairmen for terms of one year. The chairmanship shall rotate among the Parties. Meetings of the committee shall be held alternately in each of the Nordic countries.
