No. 6589. AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> ON CULTURAL CO-OPERATION  
BETWEEN THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST  
REPUBLICS AND THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK.  
SIGNED AT MOSCOW, ON 11 SEPTEMBER 1962

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The Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the Government of the Kingdom of Denmark, desiring to develop cultural relations between the two countries on the basis of the principles of respect for sovereignty, non-intervention in domestic affairs and equal rights, endeavouring through co-operation and exchange in this sphere to improve mutual understanding and strengthen friendship between the Soviet and Danish peoples, and convinced that this represents a useful contribution to the cause of strengthening international relations on a peaceful basis, have decided to conclude this Agreement.

*Article I*

The Contracting Parties shall promote :

1. The development of cultural co-operation between the two countries in the theatre, the cinema, pictorial art and music through the exchange of visits by delegations and individuals active in art, literature and the Press, the organization of tours for individual performers and groups of performers, the holding of art exhibitions, etc.;
2. A broader acquaintance with the works of Soviet and Danish writers and composers in Denmark and the USSR respectively, as well as the study in each country of the other country's literature, history, geography and culture;
3. The development of relations in science and in higher and other education through visits by delegations and individual scientists, teachers and post-graduate and undergraduate students, the exchange of publications and museum exhibits, and more extensive use of libraries and archives for scientific purposes;
4. The exchange, on a non-commercial basis, of educational and information films, film strips and tape recordings;
5. The exchange, for scientific and technological purposes, of specialists in industry, construction, transport and other fields of economic activity;
6. The unobstructed development of cultural relations between Soviet and Danish non-governmental organizations and institutions, on the understand-
