Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to recent conversations between representatives of our two Governments concerning the establishment of arrangements under which men and women of the United States of America who volunteer to serve in the Peace Corps may reside in the Republic of Chile for such time as may be necessary in order for them to engage in work beneficial to the Republic of Chile as Peace Corps Volunteers. Pursuant to those conversations, in which it was indicated that the Government of the Republic of Chile would welcome such Volunteers, I have the honor to propose the following understanding with respect to Peace Corps Volunteers and Peace Corps programs :

1. The Government of the United States agrees to furnish such Peace Corps Volunteers as may be requested by the Government of the Republic of Chile and approved by the Government of the United States to perform mutually agreed tasks in the Republic of Chile. The Government of the Republic of Chile agrees for its part to accord equitable treatment to the Volunteers and their property and to afford them full aid and protection, including treatment no less favorable than that accorded generally to nationals of the United States residing in the Republic of Chile. Both parties agree fully to inform, consult and cooperate with the representatives of the other Government with respect to all pertinent matters concerning the Volunteers. The Government of the Republic of Chile agrees to receive a representative of the Peace Corps and such staff members and other personnel as are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Chile who will perform functions for the Government of the United States hereunder.

2. Appropriate representatives of the Government of the United States and the Government of the Republic of Chile may make from time to time such mutually acceptable arrangements with respect to the Peace Corps Volunteers and Peace Corps programs in the Republic of Chile as appear necessary or desirable for the purpose of implementing this Agreement.
