Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to recent conversations between representatives of our two governments concerning the furnishing of assistance by the Government of the United States of America to the Government of Paraguay for the purpose of increasing the air transport capability of the Paraguayan Air Force and to propose the following understandings with respect to this assistance.

1. Aircraft and related equipment and services will be furnished for this purpose subject to the terms and conditions of applicable United States laws and regulations. They shall not be used for any purpose other than transportation and logistic support within Paraguay and shall not be transferred to, nor used by, anyone not an officer, employee or agent of the Government of Paraguay, without the prior consent of the United States. The Government of Paraguay will provide substantially the same degree of security protection afforded to such aircraft, equipment and services by the Government of the United States of America.

2. The Government of Paraguay will, as the United States may require, permit continuous observation and review by, and furnish necessary information to, representatives of the Government of the United States of America with regard to the use of such aircraft, equipment and services, and will offer for return to the United States such aircraft or equipment when no longer needed for the purpose of transportation and logistic support.

I have the honor to propose that, if these understandings are acceptable to the Government of Paraguay, the present note and your note in reply concurring therein
