No. 6702. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF AUSTRALIA RELATING TO A SEMINAR ON THE ROLE OF THE POLICE IN THE PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS. SIGNED AT CANBERRA, ON 13 MAY 1963

The United Nations and the Government of Australia (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON THE ROLE OF THE POLICE IN THE PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

1. A United Nations seminar on the role of the police in the protection of human rights shall be held in Canberra, Australia, in April-May, 1963.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be two weeks.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to give the national participants and other persons attending the seminar an opportunity to exchange views and experiences on the role of the police in the protection of human rights.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

Participation in the seminar shall be open to :

(a) National participants, alternates and observers nominated by the governments of states and territories within the geographical scope of the Economic Commission for Asia and the Far East, with the addition of Australia and New Zealand, and confirmed by the Secretary-General. A chairman shall be elected by the national participants from among themselves to preside at the seminar. Vice-chairmen and rapporteurs shall also be elected as appropriate in the same manner.
