Bridgetown, January 7, 1963

Excellency :

I refer to our recent conversations concerning the High Altitude Research Project (HARP) being undertaken by McGill University and the Tropical Weather Research Project being undertaken by Florida State University in Barbados.

It is the understanding of the United States Government that both McGill University and Florida State University, as private contractors, have authorization from the Government of Barbados to undertake experiments of this nature.

The United States Government has made available to McGill University for the latter's experimental purposes certain United States Government-owned property, to wit :

- 1 16" gun assembly with loading mechanism
- 1 16" gun barrel for reserve
- 11,000 lbs. propellant
- 1 400 cycle motor generator for use with M-33 radar
- 1 M-33 radar system

The United States Government has also made available to Florida State University certain other United States Government-owned property for that University's experimental purposes, to wit :
