Your Excellency,

With reference to the negotiations which have taken place between representatives of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of the Government of Vietnam concerning the exchange of official publications, I have the honour to propose, on behalf of Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom, that there shall be an exchange of official publications between the two Governments in accordance with the following provisions :

- (1) Each Government shall supply regularly, carriage paid to destination, one copy of each of the serial publications specified on a list which shall be prepared for the purposes of the exchange and which shall be agreed upon by the authorities referred to in sub-paragraph 4. Alterations to either list, and arrangements for the supply of additional copies of any serial publication listed may be made by agreement between the authorities referred to in sub-paragraph 4. Arrangements for the supply of back numbers, of any date, of serial publications may also be made by agreement between the authorities referred to in sub-paragraph 4.
- (2) Each Government shall, at the request of the other Government, supply non-serial publications according to arrangements which shall be agreed upon by the authorities referred to in sub-paragraph 4.
- (3) Each Government shall aim at ensuring that the total cost of the publications supplied shall be approximately equal to that of the publications received.
- (4) The authority responsible for the transmission of publications of the Government of the United Kingdom shall be Her Majesty's Stationery Office. The authority
