No. 6960. AGREEMENT¹ ON CULTURAL CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC
AND THE REPUBLIC OF SOMALIA. SIGNED AT
PRAGUE, ON 4 JUNE 1961

The Government of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the Government of the Republic of Somalia, being desirous of expanding cultural relations between the two countries in the interests of the further development and strengthening of the friendly relations between the Somali and Czechoslovak peoples, have agreed as follows :

Article I

The Contracting Parties will strengthen and expand cultural exchanges for their mutual benefit within the framework of the laws operating in each country and on the basis of the principles of respect for sovereignty, noninterference into each other's domestic affairs, and equality.

Article II

The Contracting Parties will promote, within their possibilities and requirements, the development of co-operation, the exchange of experience and achievements in science, higher learning and public education, health protection, literature, arts, and sports by exchanging delegations and individual visits, will encourage mutual acquaintance of their peoples with the culture of the other Party and with this aim will invite musical and theatrical companies, actors, will organise concerts, arts exhibitions, lectures and so on.

The Contracting Parties will promote cultural exchanges between non-governmental organizations of both countries.

Article III

The Contracting Parties will encourage co-operation on a mutually acceptable basis in the distribution of books and magazines, and also in the sphere of broadcasting and cinematography and the distribution of films, exchange of radio programmes and musical recordings.
