No. 6987. CULTURAL CONVENTION<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE BELGIAN GOVERNMENT AND THE TUNISIAN GOVERNMENT. SIGNED AT BRUSSELS, ON 21 DECEMBER 1962

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The Belgian Government, on the one hand, and the Tunisian Government, on the other,

Desiring to strengthen their cultural relations and to intensify their friendly co-operation in literary, scientific, artistic, educational and technical matters,

Have decided to conclude this Convention and have to this end appointed as their plenipotentiaries,

The Belgian Government :

His Excellency Mr. P.-H. Spaak, Minister for Foreign Affairs ;

The Tunisian Government :

His Excellency Mr. S. El Goulli, Ambassador of the Republic of Tunisia in Brussels,

who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

*Article 1*

The Contracting Parties undertake to encourage and to develop to the greatest possible extent relations between the two countries in scientific, technical, academic, scholastic, artistic and cultural matters, in order to help in spreading knowledge of each other's culture and intellectual activities.

*Article 2*

The Contracting Parties shall endeavour to facilitate and promote exchanges of teachers at the various levels of education, and of research workers, students and trainees, specialists, technicians or other persons carrying on a cultural or technical activity.

*Article 3*

Each Contracting Party undertakes to encourage nationals of the other Party to undertake or pursue courses of study or of training in its territory, by providing scholarships or grants.
