No. 7020. AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING CULTURAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE POLISH PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC AND THE REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CUBA. SIGNED AT HAVANA, ON 6 MARCH 1961

The Government of the Polish People's Republic and the Government of the Republic of Cuba, desiring to promote co-operation between the peoples of the two countries in the sphere of education, science and culture, and convinced that such co-operation will serve to strengthen the bonds of friendship between the two countries, have decided to conclude an Agreement concerning cultural co-operation and for this purpose have agreed as follows :

Article I

The Contracting Parties shall promote co-operation in the sphere of education, science and culture and in that of public information.

Article II

The Contracting Parties undertake to promote in particular : co-operation between their establishments of higher learning, scientific research institutes, and technical, educational and cultural organizations; the exchange of information and materials in the sphere of education, science and culture; the organization of conferences and the exchange of persons engaged in educational, scientific and cultural activities; the exchange of scientific, technical, literary and artistic works and publications, and the translation and publication of such works; the exchange of films and the organization of concerts, theatrical presentations, artistic and technical exhibitions, and sports and other events.

Article III

Each Contracting Party shall, subject to the regulations in force and to the statutes of the institutions concerned, provide opportunities for scientific workers of the other Contracting Party to engage in research and study at educational establishments, institutes, archives, libraries and museums in its country.
