No. 7067. EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF GREECE CONCERNING VISAS. CANBERRA, 6 DECEMBER 1961

Sir,

With reference to our recent discussions, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of New Zealand is prepared to conclude with the Royal Greek Government an agreement to facilitate travel between our two countries on the following basis :

(1) Greek nationals possessing valid Greek passports who hold permits to enter New Zealand for permanent residence, or who desire to enter New Zealand for a bona fide visit, will be issued with appropriate visas free of charge by the appropriate visa-issuing authority. In the case of a Greek national holding a permit to enter New Zealand for permanent residence, a visa will be made valid for a period corresponding to the period within which he is required to exercise his right to enter New Zealand in accordance with the permit. In the case of a Greek national proceeding to New Zealand on a bona fide visit, a visa will be made valid for a period of twelve months and good for an appropriate number of journeys to New Zealand within that period.

(2) New Zealand citizens possessing valid New Zealand passports may enter Greece without obtaining a visa, provided the entry is not made with the intention of staying in Greece for a period longer than three months, or with the intention of entering into gainful employment or occupation.

(3) New Zealand citizens possessing valid New Zealand passports, who desire to enter Greece in order to take up gainful employment, or for a period of longer than three months, and whose entry has been approved, will be issued with appropriate visas free of charge by the appropriate visa-issuing authority.
