Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to conversations which have been held between representatives of the United States of America and of Argentina regarding the desire of the Government of the United States to put into effect, pursuant to the Tariff Classification Act of 1962, the proposed Tariff Schedules of the United States, before the completion of such consultations or negotiations as may be necessary to reach agreement on the modification of the United States Schedules to the trade agreement of October 14, 1941² (Schedules II and III), in order to conform these schedules to the Tariff Schedules of the United States.

It is my understanding of such conversations that the Government of Argentina will not object to the prompt effectiveness of the Tariff Schedules of the United States ; provided that during the period from the effective date of the said Tariff Schedules to the completion of such consultations and negotiations, the United States does not, except pursuant to the provisions of the trade agreement of October 14, 1941, increase a column 1 rate in the said Tariff Schedules above the level provided therefor under the Tariff Classification Act, if such classification includes any product now provided for in either of the United States schedules described in the first paragraph of this note. Moreover, the United States recognizes Argentina's right to any such compensation as may mutually be deemed to be necessary, as a result of the consultations and negotiations now going on.

If the above also represents Your Excellency's understanding of these conversations, and it is agreeable to the Government of Argentina, I propose that this note and Your Excellency's reply so indicating will constitute an agreement between our two Governments.
