No. 7135. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY ON TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE DEIR EL HAJAR EXPERIMENTAL STOCK FARM. SIGNED AT DAMASCUS, ON 25 JUNE 1962

The Government of the Syrian Arab Republic, represented by Mr. Abdel Wahab Akkad, Minister of Agriculture, and

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, represented by Mr. Rudolf Fechter, its Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary,

Desiring to deepen and strengthen the ties of friendship existing between their two countries and peoples, and having regard to their common interest in the granting and strengthening of technical and economic assistance, and to the advantages that would accrue to both States from closer technical and economic co-operation, have agreed as follows :

Article I

1. The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany shall provide at its expense, for the development of the Deir el Hajar experimental stock farm provided for this purpose by the Government of the Syrian Arab Republic :

(a) For a period of three years, six German agricultural specialists as follows :

An expert in stock breeding,

An expert in fodder crops,

An expert in the breeding and artificial insemination of cattle,

A laboratory assistant,

A technician for the maintenance of agricultural machinery,

A dairy foreman;

(b) The technical equipment for three laboratories, for research respectively in milk, wool, and fodder crops;

(c) The technical equipment for artificial insemination, breeding and clinical work;
