No. 7334. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF TOGO RELATING TO A UNITED NATIONS SEMINAR ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN IN FAMILY LAW. SIGNED AT LOMÉ, ON 3 JULY 1964

The United Nations and the Government of Togo (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN IN FAMILY LAW

1. A United Nations seminar on the status of women in family law will be held at Lomé, Togo.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 18 to 31 August 1964 inclusive.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to provide an opportunity for an exchange of experience and information concerning the status of women in family law.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

Participation in the seminar shall be open to :

(a) National participants and alternates nominated by the Governments of countries which are members of the Economic Commission for Africa. A Chairman shall be elected by the national participants from among themselves to preside at the seminar. Vice-chairmen and rapporteurs shall also be elected in the same manner ;

(b) Observers from other States Members of the United Nations ;

(c) Representatives from any specialized agencies of the United Nations which may be invited by the United Nations to send representatives ;
