Excellency :

I have the honor to refer to recent conversations between representatives of our two Governments concerning the furnishing of assistance by the Government of the United States of America to the Government of Paraguay for the purpose of promoting the defense of Paraguay by increasing the road construction and maintenance capability of the Paraguayan Army and to propose the following understanding with respect to this assistance :

1. Road construction and maintenance equipment, and related materials and services, will be furnished for the above-mentioned purpose subject to the terms and conditions of applicable United States laws and regulations, and to such other conditions as may be specified in arrangements between representatives of our two Governments. The equipment, materials and services to be provided under this agreement shall not be used for any purpose other than road construction and maintenance in Paraguay and shall not be transferred to, nor used by, anyone not an officer, employee or agent of the Government of Paraguay, without the prior consent of the United States Government. The Government of Paraguay will provide substantially the same degree of security protection as that afforded to such equipment, materials and services by the Government of the United States of America.

2. The Government of Paraguay will, as the United States may require, permit continuous observation and review by, and furnish necessary information to, representatives of the Government of the United States of America with regard to the use of such equipment, materials and services, and will offer for return to the United States such equipment and materials when no longer needed for the purpose of road construction and maintenance.
