No. 7458. CULTURAL AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND THE UNITED STATES OF BRAZIL. SIGNED AT RIO DE JANEIRO, ON 24 JUNE 1959

The Government of the State of Israel and the Government of the United States of Brazil ;

Desiring to strengthen the relations of friendship existing between the two countries ;

Believing that these relations may be intensified and developed by the dissemination of information about the intellectual, scientific and artistic progress achieved in the two countries ;

Considering, therefore, that it is desirable and necessary to strengthen the cultural ties existing between the two countries ;

Have agreed as follows :

Article I

The Governments of the State of Israel and the United States of Brazil shall do their utmost to develop and facilitate cultural exchanges between Israel and Brazil in the fields of literature, science, the plastic arts, the theatre, the cinema, photography, radio, sport and tourism.

Article II

In order to achieve the purposes mentioned in the preceding article, the Contracting Parties shall encourage visits by intellectuals, teachers and members of artistic, literary, scientific and sports societies or institutes for the purpose of working, delivering lectures and organizing exhibitions in their special fields or of taking part in congresses, meetings or competitions.

Article III

The Contracting Parties shall promote exchanges of visits by theatrical companies, orchestras, entertainment troupes or individual entertainers and sports teams or athletes.
