No. 7464. CULTURAL CONVENTION¹ BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE PERUVIAN REPUBLIC.
SIGNED AT LIMA, ON 25 JUNE 1962

The Government of the Peruvian Republic and the Government of the State of Israel,

Desiring to strengthen the friendly relations existing between the Peruvian Republic and the State of Israel ; and

Convinced that the ties between the two peoples can be still further strengthened by the dissemination of information about the intellectual, scientific and artistic progress achieved in each of the two countries ;

And believing therefore that there should be closer cultural bonds between the two peoples,

Have decided to conclude a cultural convention and for that purpose have appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Peruvian Republic : Dr. Luis Alvarado G., Minister for Foreign Affairs, and Dr. Dario Acevedo Criado, Minister for Education ;

The Government of the State of Israel : Dr. Michael Simon, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Peru ;

who, having exhibited their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article I

The Contracting Parties shall do everything possible to increase and facilitate cultural exchanges between their two countries and shall take all measures within their power to this end ; they shall, in particular :

1. Encourage the creation at universities in each country of professorial chairs in the language, literature, history, culture and art of the other Contracting Party.

2. Grant facilities, on a basis of reciprocity, to research workers and scientists to continue their studies and undertake research in scientific institutions in the other country.
