No. 7513. AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING CULTURAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF BELGIUM AND THE ROMANIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC. SIGNED AT BRUSSELS, ON 13 NOVEMBER 1963

The Government of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Government of the Romanian People's Republic,

Desiring to foster cultural co-operation between the two countries,

Have decided to conclude the present Agreement and for this purpose have appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Kingdom of Belgium :

His Excellency Mr. Paul-Henri Spaak, Minister for Foreign Affairs;

The Government of the Romanian People's Republic :

His Excellency Mr. Pavel Babuci, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of the Romanian People's Republic in Belgium,

Who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article I

The two Contracting Parties shall foster co-operation in the sciences, technology and education, and co-operation between institutions for scientific, technical and educational research, through :

(a) Exchange visits by scientists, teachers and specialists with a view to undertaking further study, giving lectures and exchanging experience;

(b) The establishment of scholarships and of research and specialization fellowships.

Article II

Each Party shall encourage invitations to members of the teaching profession and students of the other Party to attend summer courses held in its territory.

Article III

The two Parties shall facilitate the exchange of scientific, technical and literary works in general, and in particular between the principal libraries of the two
