No. 7534. CULTURAL AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES AND PAKISTAN. SIGNED AT RAWALPINDI, ON 15 AUGUST 1961

The Republic of the Philippines and Pakistan, conscious of their common spiritual, intellectual and artistic traditions and desirous of strengthening and perpetuating the bonds of cultural, artistic, and scientific cooperation between them ;

Have decided to conclude a Cultural Agreement and have, to this end, appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

For the Republic of the Philippines :

His Excellency, Dr. José Alejandrino, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of the Philippines in Pakistan

For Pakistan :

Mr. Akhter Husain, H. Pk., Minister for Education and Scientific Research
who having examined each other's credentials and found them good and in due form, have agreed as follows :

Article I

The High Contracting Parties will encourage the establishment of cultural institutes in each other's territory subject to the legal requirements governing the establishment of such institutes in that territory and the general policy of its Government.

The term "Cultural Institute" shall be deemed to include libraries ; scientific institutions of an educational nature ; and institutions for the promotion of art, such as art galleries, art centres and societies, and film libraries dedicated to the study of the culture concerned.

Article II

The High Contracting Parties will encourage and facilitate the exchange between their respective countries of professors and teachers of universities and other educational institutions on terms to be agreed upon between their governments.

¹ Came into force on 14 October 1964, fifteen days after the exchange of the instruments of ratification which took place at Manila on 29 September 1964, in accordance with article XII.
