No. 7536. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF YUGOSLAVIA RELATING TO A HUMAN RIGHTS SEMINAR TO BE HELD AT BELGRADE FROM 8 TO 22 JUNE 1965. SIGNED AT NEW YORK, ON 7 JANUARY 1965

The United Nations and the Government of Yugoslavia (hereinafter called "the Government"), desiring to give effect to the provisions of General Assembly resolution 926 (X)² concerning the programme of advisory services in human rights, have agreed as follows :

Article I

SEMINAR ON THE MULTINATIONAL SOCIETY

1. A United Nations seminar on the multinational society will be held in Belgrade, Yugoslavia.
2. The duration of the seminar shall be from 8 to 22 June 1965, inclusive.
3. The purpose of the seminar shall be to provide an opportunity for exchange of experience concerning the multinational society.

Article II

PARTICIPATION IN THE SEMINAR

1. Participation in the seminar shall be open to :
 - (a) Participants and alternates nominated by the Governments of countries selected on a world-wide basis by a working party convened by the Secretary-General of the delegations represented on the sessional Committees of the Economic and Social Council ;
 - (b) Observers from other States Members of the United Nations ;
 - (c) Representatives from any specialized agencies of the United Nations which may be invited by the United Nations to send representatives ;
