No. 7680. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE ROYAL THAI GOVERNMENT AND THE ROYAL DANISH GOVERNMENT CONCERNING TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION ON GENETICS AND SILVICULTURE OF TEAK. SIGNED AT BANGKOK, ON 25 JANUARY 1965

The Royal Thai Government and the Royal Danish Government, desirous of strengthening the friendly relations between the two countries and their peoples, and recognizing their mutual interest in the economic and technical development of their countries, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The object of the cooperation under this Agreement is to promote the genetical and silvicultural research of teak (*Tectona grandis*) in Thailand, to ensure a continuous and improved regeneration of teak and to improve teak quality.

Article 2

The Thai Government will provide a suitable site for an experiment station and nursery. An area of 25 hectares will be made available, and an adjacent area of about 150 hectares will be reserved for possible later extensions.

Existing buildings on the said area will be made available to the extent that they can be used in the implementation of the project. The Thai Government will pay the cost of construction and maintenance of all additional buildings which may be deemed necessary by both sides to erect under the project.

The Thai Government will bear all costs in connection with fencing, clearing, draining and levelling of the ground, as well as the costs in connection with the necessary road construction and the securing of water for the project.

Article 3

The Danish Government will provide and pay for one expert on forest genetics and, at least during the first one or two years of the project, an assistant to him.
