No. 7681. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK REPUBLIC AND THE REPUBLIC OF EGYPT ON CULTURAL CO-OPERATION. SIGNED AT CAIRO, ON 19 OCTOBER 1957

The Government of the Czechoslovak Republic and the Government of the Republic of Egypt,

being desirous of promoting the friendly relations between the peoples of the two countries,

endeavouring to achieve closer co-operation between the two countries in all spheres of arts, science, education, enlightenment, physical culture and sport,

have agreed to conclude the present Agreement and have, therefore, appointed their Plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Czechoslovak Republic, Mr. Arnošt Karpíšek, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Czechoslovak Republic in the Republic of Egypt,

The Government of the Republic of Egypt, Mr. Ali Sabry, Minister of Foreign Affairs a.i.,

who having exchanged their credentials and having found them to be in good and proper form, have agreed on the following provisions :

Article 1

The Two Contracting Parties shall accord each other mutual help in all that may encourage scientific and artistic co-operation between them ; and to this end, have agreed specially upon the following :

A) The Two Contracting Parties shall encourage the exchange, between their respective countries, of university professors and scientists engaged in scientific research and between institutes and universities in both countries ;

B) Each of the Two Contracting Parties shall seek to accord favourable customs treatment to shipments of educational materials for schools and laboratories and shall make such education materials and similar items available to the other Contracting Party ;
