No. 7682. AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING CO-OPERATION IN
MATTERS OF HEALTH BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK
REPUBLIC AND THE POLISH REPUBLIC. SIGNED AT
WARSAW, ON 17 NOVEMBER 1950

The Government of the Czechoslovak Republic and the Government of the Polish Republic, aspiring to intensify their mutual relations and co-operation in matters of health in the spirit of the Treaty of friendship and mutual aid between the Czechoslovak Republic and the Polish Republic, have decided to conclude an agreement concerning co-operation in matters of health between the Czechoslovak Republic and the Polish Republic and have for this purpose appointed as their plenipotentiaries:

The Government of the Czechoslovak Republic :

Mr. Richard Slánský, Minister Plenipotentiary ;

The Government of the Polish Republic :

Dr. Tadeusz Michejda, Minister of Health,

who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The two States shall co-operate and assist each other on all questions and in all branches of health, thus striving to raise systematically, during the period of building socialism, the level of the people's health in both States.

To that end they shall foster the exchange of experience and keep each other fully informed of achievements in the field of public health.

Co-operation in health planning shall take effect primarily in working out plans of health care in the two States.

Article 2

The two States shall enter into close co-operation in the provision of health care.

They shall foster mutual health care, which shall be provided in particular
