No. 7745. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE FRENCH REPUBLIC AND THE KINGDOM OF GREECE ON TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC CO-OPERATION. SIGNED AT PARIS, ON 25 JULY 1960

The Government of the French Republic and the Government of the Kingdom of Greece,

Desiring to promote between their two countries, which are linked by very old and close cultural ties, further exchanges in fields of intellectual endeavour,

Desiring to develop technical and scientific co-operation between the two countries as a contribution to their economic and social progress, have agreed on the following provisions :

Article 1

The two Governments shall establish a system for technical and scientific co-operation between them in such fields and according to such methods as will be subsequently determined by means of supplementary agreements or arrangements made under the present Agreement, which shall serve as the basic agreement.

Article 2

Such co-operation may be effected through :

(a) The assignment of experts and scientists to the other Party for the purpose of participating in studies and in the training and advanced training of scientific and technical staff or for the purpose of giving technical advice on specific problems ;

(b) Participation in seminars, training programmes, demonstrations, working groups of experts, research workers and technicians, and activities related to the foregoing ;

(c) The organization of training or advanced training courses and the granting of scholarships or fellowships ;

(d) The exchange of documentary material, the sponsoring of lectures, the presentation of films and the dissemination of technical and scientific information by any other means ;

(e) Any other forms of action which may be agreed upon by the Parties.
