No. 7831. AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY CONCERNING COMPENSATION FOR UNITED KINGDOM NATIONALS WHO WERE VICTIMS OF NATIONAL-SOCIALIST MEASURES OF PERSECUTION. SIGNED AT BONN, ON 9 JUNE 1964

The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Federal Republic of Germany have agreed as follows :

Article 1

(1) The Federal Republic of Germany shall pay to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as " the United Kingdom ") the sum of one million pounds sterling for the benefit of United Kingdom nationals who were victims of National-Socialist measures of persecution and who, as a result of such measures, suffered loss of liberty or damage to their health, or, in the case of those who died in consequence of such measures, for the benefit of their dependents.

(2) The distribution of this sum shall be left to the discretion of Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom.

Article 2

The Federal Republic of Germany shall place the aforesaid sum at the disposal of the United Kingdom three months after the entry into force of the present Agreement.

Article 3

Without prejudice to any rights of United Kingdom nationals arising from legislation or special agreements in force, the payment provided for in paragraph (1) of Article 1 shall constitute a final settlement, as between the United Kingdom and the Federal Republic of Germany, of all questions concerning compensation for the measures of persecution referred to in that Article.
