No. 7834. AGREEMENT¹ FOR CULTURAL CO-OPERATION
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KING-
DOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC
OF CAMEROON. SIGNED AT LONDON, ON 20 AUGUST
1963

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Federal Republic of Cameroon;

Considering that by virtue of the constitution of the Federal Republic of Cameroon, the English language is one of the official languages of the Federation;

Considering that instruction of an English character is, or should become for the Cameroonian people, in conformity with its national traditions, one of the instruments for its cultural, political, economic and social development, and for the fulfilment of the bi-cultural and bilingual vocation of the Federation;

Convinced that co-operation between the two countries in the fields of education, culture and sport will serve to strengthen the special links which freely unite them;

Have to this end agreed to promote within the means at their disposal the following measure :

Article 1

The Contracting Parties undertake to promote by all appropriate means, effective co-operation in the fields of education, culture and sport as rightful partners on the basis of friendly relations and of the principle of respect for sovereignty and of non-interference.

Article 2

(1) The Government of the United Kingdom in particular undertake both in the territory of the Federal Republic of Cameroon and in their own territory, to facilitate the education of Cameroon nationals wishing to receive instruction at all levels and to obtain the relevant diplomas.

(2) In particular the Government of the United Kingdom shall take appropriate measures to put at the disposal of the Government of the Federal Republic of Cameroon the qualified personnel necessary for the functioning of public or private establishments of instruction and culture, for the organisation of examinations and competitive tests and for administrative services in the field of teaching.
