No. 7908. AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING CULTURAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF BELGIUM AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC. SIGNED AT BRUSSELS, ON 11 FEBRUARY 1965

The Government of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic,

Desiring to expand their relations in the fields of culture, science, education and technology,

Convinced that co-operation in these fields effectively contributes to the two countries' knowledge of each other,

Have decided to conclude this Agreement and for this purpose have appointed as their plenipotentiaries :

The Government of the Kingdom of Belgium :

His Excellency Mr. Paul Henri Spaak, Minister for Foreign Affairs;

The Government of the Hungarian People's Republic :

His Excellency Mr. Tibor Lajti, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Hungarian People's Republic;

Who, having exchanged their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows :

Article I

The two Parties shall develop co-operation in the fields of science, technology and higher education through :

(a) Co-operation between academies, universities and other higher educational establishments and scientific and technical research institutions;

(b) Exchange visits by scientists, teachers and specialists with a view to undertaking further study, giving lectures and exchanging experience;

(c) The establishment of fellowships for study, research, specialization and vacation courses.

Article II

The two Parties shall encourage the exchange of information in the field of education at all levels, especially through the exchange of members of the teaching profession.
