No. 7917. AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING CO-OPERATION IN
THE FIELD OF TOURIST TRAFFIC BETWEEN THE
CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND THE
SOCIALIST FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA.
SIGNED AT BELGRADE, ON 14 MARCH 1964

The Government of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the Government of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, seeking, in the interest of both States, to expand co-operation in the field of tourist traffic, have agreed as follows :

Article 1

The Contracting Parties shall promote and facilitate travel by tourist groups and individual tourists from one country to the other for the purpose of visiting tourist resorts, places of historical interest, fairs and exhibitions and of attending cultural, sports and other events.

Article 2

The Contracting Parties shall take steps to ease the frontier, customs and other formalities connected with the crossing of the frontiers by tourists of the two countries.

Article 3

In order to develop tourism, the Contracting Parties shall take steps to improve transport services between the two countries.

Article 4

The Contracting Parties shall take all necessary steps to enable the authorities of the two States which are responsible for tourism, and other organizations and institutions concerned with the development of tourist traffic, to co-operate with one another.

Article 5

The Contracting Parties shall promote co-operation between tourist organizations, particularly in :
